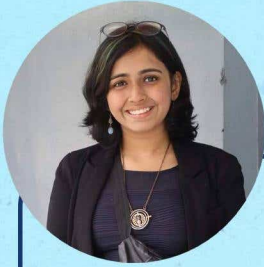

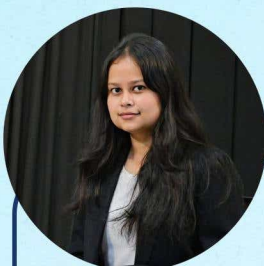
Ankita Sarmah Bordoloi
